On August 28, the children and youth Sunday school classes will begin their new year.

This is an exciting time and we invite all

the children and youth to come and be a part of our classes.

The Preschool Class will continue using the Rock Solid curriculum.

“Everyone who hears these words of mine and acts on them will be like a wise man who built his house on rock. The rain fell, the floods came, and the winds blew and beat on that house, but it did not fall because it had been founded on rock.” (Matthew 7:24 – 25) Jesus commonly used experiences to help people understand his message. What this parable is saying is exactly what we wish to offer our children. We want to help them build a strong faith foundation so that when the rains and storms of life assail them (and they will at some time or another), their house of faith will not fall away. It will stand strong and give them strength and shelter. In a variety of experiences, this class of 3 and 4’s will be invited to come to a better understanding of God and what God calls and wants them to be.

The Elementary classes meet each



week in Halleluia Hallway to grow and develop in their faith and in their relationships with each other. The classes rotate through 5 different learning experiences to learn the faith stories and

how they apply to their daily lives. **The overall emphasis for the year will be: Children are an important part of God’s family.** We will begin on August 28, with a continental breakfast for the students and an introduction to our year’s activities. **All elementary students are invited to join in room 11 for our opening time and a great beginning to the new year!**

Our first rotation for this year will be focusing on Worship.

Youth Classes meet in Conway Hall youth rooms. Their curriculum is a video/discussion based study. The classes also participate in a variety of service projects during the class time.

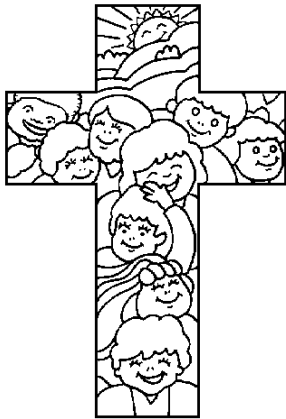

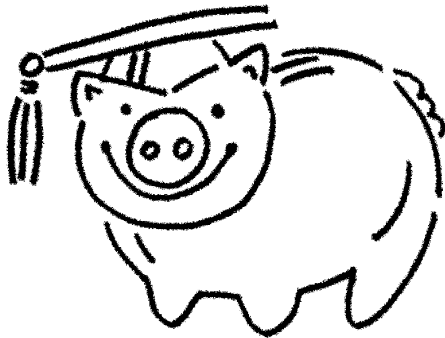

We are the Grace Covenant family – family of faith – God’s faithful people gathering for worship – learning – fellowship – service – and, of course, Presbyterian eating and meeting. We are truly a blessed people; a **BEACON** that gathers people in; our church campus a safe harbor to worship and learn and “be” the redeemed people of Jesus Christ.

Did you know that on the average Sunday, we have 376 persons attending our two worship services? We do! (This is 51 more, on average, than in 2008.) Did you know that this number (376) includes 38 visitors? Well, my friends, it is true.

And, our membership, at the end of 2010 was 703 “active” members; yet, unfortunately, many of these folk no longer attend GCPC worship or participate in any of our educational classes or fellowship activities.

We can all help. Our Board of Deacons is making a concerted effort to call all members on our Special Needs on a regular basis. Our pastors are chatting with members and visitors prior to every worship service. Many of you note that someone is missing from worship or your learning class or fellowship group and give them a call; or alert the pastors.

Yet, the fact remains that many of our members have gone astray. I cannot help but remember the **Parable of the Lost Sheep** – where the shepherd leaves the flock faithfully gathered – to go and search for the lost one. As the summer quickly draws to a close; as we gear-up for another exciting “church” year of activities ---- I challenge each one of us to search for those “lost” souls of our flock; to lead them back into the safety of our harbor. From the stormy seas that embrace many a life today, we can be that safe harbor we profess to be by the mercy and gracefulness of our God!

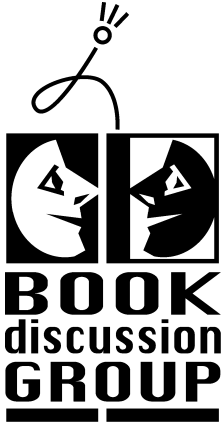

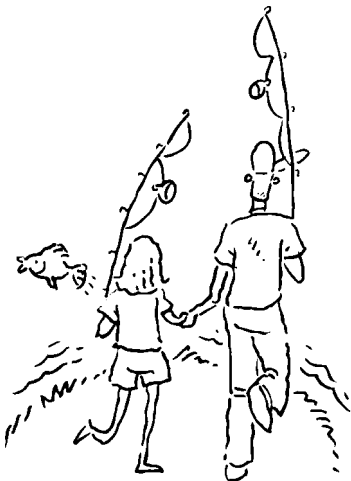

What is Cursillo?

It originated in Spain after that country's civil war, when the church there needed a revival. We retain the Spanish nomenclature to honor Cursillo's history.
