Who is Pastor Jody?

Good question! I am a native Orlandoan, as is my wife, Ellen. We grew up about half a mile from each other as the crow flies, but never knew each other til our 30's. I attended Orlando Christian School in Pine Hills from K-9th grade, then graduated from West Orange High in 1989. I am also a UCF grad (go Knights!).

When I met Ellen, she introduced me to Park Lake Presbyterian Church, which I joined in 2003. Next thing I knew, I was ordained as a ruling elder. Near the end of my term on the session, I heard a call to serve God in pastoral ministry. I graduated from The University of Dubuque Theological Seminary in 2013. While in seminary, I interned at FPC Lake Mary and Grace Covenant (as interim codirector of youth), and earned one unit of Clinical

Pastoral Education credit at Nemours Children's Hospital. I was also employed by Central Florida Presbytery in those days, serving as the administrative assistant to the executive presbyter. I think of that position as my "third internship" since it was so valuable in learning about the "wheels of the presby-bus."

My first call was to Markham Woods Presbyterian Church in Lake Mary (near Heathrow) from 2017-2022. This past summer, I served as a commissioner from Central Florida Presbytery to the 222nd General Assembly--a great honor and responsibility. I also preached all summer at Maitland PC while their co-pastors were on sabbatical, and have written articles for Presbyterian News Service, the Presbyterian Foundation, and The Presbyterian Outlook magazine.
