Session Summary January 2023

In January, the session approved a budget for 2023. It also approved the revitalization of the 5 Cents Per Meal offering benefitting hunger relief through the presbytery. It also approved dates for special offerings of the synod and General Assembly.

The session began a "meeting partnership" with the deacons. One deacon will be present at every session meeting, and one active elder will be present at every deacon meeting. We are confident that this "mutual indwelling" will bear fruit in our common ministry.

In people news, the session was grateful to re-elect Diana Ibarra as Clerk of Session and Bruce Lampman as Treasurer. It nominated folks for the boards of Grace Covenant Presbyterian Church Foundation and Grace Covenant Presbyterian Church, Inc. for the respective annual meetings of those bodies. It also approved a new member of the board of Small Blessings Child Care.

Finally, it elected two commissioners for the March meeting of presbytery and approved requests to use the sanctuary for non-worship gatherings.

Lent is traditionally a season of solemn introspection and even self-denial. Fasting is common, in addition to other spiritual disciplines. But it can be a time of development as well as denial. In pursuing our creative gifts, we affirm the image of the Divine Creator in us.

So mark your calendars with pencil, colored ink, or crayons and plan to join together on Ash Wednesday for soup and bread in Conway Hall at 6pm. Then we will have a brief reflective worship including imposition of ashes at 6:30 in the sanctuary.

Look for a weekly devotion using Matisse's life and art as a companion to our scriptures and Lenten disciplines. Sunday School lessons and the sermon series will also be colored by the material. We hope that this artistic approach to Lent will be meaningful for you.
