One of my long-term goals for Grace Covenant is to have a staff member whose primary job is church communication. This person would be responsible for worship media, newsletter production, social media, and other ways we keep the church informed of our ministry and witness. In the meantime, I do a lot of this work with the help of staff and volunteers.

In order to maximize "effective frequency," it helps to have multiple methods to get the word out. And since people tend to open text messages more frequently than emails, using a text service is a smart move to increase your reach. So I created a Flocknote account for the church to be able to quickly text and/or email church members and friends

as needed. This is helpful because many people have either a phone number or an email listed, but not both. With Flocknote, we hope to expand our reach. Depending on its success, I may even switch to it for the Grace Cov-e-news emails that I send on Fridays.

One advantage of Flocknote is that we can use it to create subgroups. I created groups for deacons, elders and staff, as well as a group called "Grace in Action" that a few folks have already joined. We will message that group with opportunities to serve as they occur.

Many of you should have already received a text/email from Grace Covenant Presbyterian Church that looks different from the Friday emails and ordinary emails sent from our grace.to address. You may opt out of such messages if you like, and instructions to do so are included with each email/text. If you have not seen a text or an email from Grace Covenant Presbyterian Church that looks different from what you usually see, there are two ways to sign up:

by texting the keyword MARK1234 (caps not required) to the short code 84576 on your phone, or by signing up at the website gracecovorl.flocknote.com.

Of course, we will still mail Grace Notes . It may not have all the same information, since email and text is more timely. But we want to keep our flock connected in every way possible. Who knows-- maybe I'll sign us up for a carrier pigeon service next! Thanks for your understanding and flexibility as we try new things.
